RULE CHANGES

The Committee wishes to submit an amended version of the constitution to the Registrar of Incorporated Societies, with the following changes:

- ◇ all misspellings and grammatical errors be corrected (throughout)
- ◇ Chair/President be changed to Chair (throughout)
- ◇ the number of committee members shall be increased from three to five, in addition to the Officers (4.3)
- ◇ a committee member will hold office for a term of two years (5.2c)
- ◇ paragraphs 20.1 and 20.2 be deleted and 20.3 renumbered.
